## ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must:

- Provide documentation of U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident status
- Have completed first year of undergraduate studies toward a STEM major and plan to pursue a four-year degree
- Demonstrate clear interests in the biomedical & behavioral sciences
- Demonstrate an understanding of the importance of having a diverse research community in the U.S.
- Be available from June 12 to July 21, 2017
- Work eight hours per day during internship
- Commute to and from UMBC
- Embrace *group* summer research opportunities
- Complete application for nonexempt UMBC position

## TIMELINE

- April 1, 2017– Nomination deadline
- April 15, 2017 – Selections announced
- May 1, 2017 – Internships confirmed
- June 1, 2017 – Team assignments finalized  
Students rank research projects based on their interests
- June 12, 2017 – Paid internship begins
- July 4, 2017 – Holiday (UMBC closed)
- July 20, 2017 – Research Symposium (9 a.m. to 12 p.m.)
- July 21, 2017 – Internship concludes
