ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must:

- Provide documentation of U.S. Citizenship or Permanent Resident status
- *Have completed first year of undergraduate studies towards a STEM major and plan to pursue a 4-year degree*
- **Demonstrate clear interests in the biomedical and behavioral sciences**
- Demonstrate the importance of having a diverse research community in the U.S.
- Be available June 11 - July 20, 2018
- Work 8 hours a day (8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.) during the internship
- Commute to and from UMBC
- Embrace group summer research experiences
- Complete application for nonexempt UMBC employment

April 15, 2018 – Selections announced
May 1, 2018 – Internships confirmed
June 1, 2018 – Team assignments finalized
(Students rank research projects based on interests)
July 11, 2018 – Paid internship begins
July 4, 2018 – Holiday (UMBC closed)
July 19, 2018 – Research Symposium (9 a.m. to 12 p.m.)
July 20, 2018 – Internship ends
