ELIGIBILITY Nominees must:

- · Provide official documentation of U.S. Citizenship or Permanent Resident status
- Have completed first year of undergraduate studies towards a STEM major and plan to pursue a 4-year degree
- Demonstrate clear interests in the biomedical sciences
- Understand the importance of having a diverse research community in the U.S.
- Commit to be available May 26-July 17, 2020
- Work 8 hours a day (8-4:30 pm) during the internship, Monday-Friday
- Commute to and from UMBC (parking passes provided)
- Embrace group summer research experiences
- Complete application for Contingent 1 UMBC non-exempt employment
 Agree to participate in ongoing evaluation activities about internship impact
